## Memorandum of Understanding

Tata Power Renewable Energy Limited (the Company) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Government of Gujarat (GoG) to develop 10,000 MW of Renewable Energy Power projects across multiple sites in Gujarat.

The signing ceremony took place at the Vibrant Gujarat event earlier today in the presence of key representatives from both, the GoG and the Company. This collaboration will support achieving the ambitious goal of generating 50% of power from renewable sources by 2030.

This MoU highlights the Company's commitment to contributing substantially to India's renewable energy landscape.
