Shinde MLAs are disillusioned now, says NCP state chief

THE NATIONALIST Congress Party (NCP) on Wednesday claimed that the MLAs supporting Chief Minister Eknath Shinde are disillusioned and rethinking their decision. NCP state president Jayant Patil said the political scenario in the state is likely to change in the coming weeks.

"This government has been struggling from day one. Those who quit Shiv Sena had done that with certain ambitions and people are realising that. Even those who quit are rethinking the decision and some are even ready to return. Maharashtra will witness a different political scenario in coming weeks," said Patil. He said that despite various attempts by people to dominate Uddhav Thackeray, he will never bow down.

"Maharashtra has witnessed destruction due to heavy rains in Marathwada and Pune city. But both the chief minister and deputy CM are wasting days in keeping Delhi happy. CM and DCM are busy in all things other than providing relief to the people of Maharashtra. They want to keep Delhi happy and nothing else," said Patil.

DIWALI PAHAT AT THANE

HC dismisses plea by Uddhav-led Sena against nod to Shinde faction

THE BOMBAY High Court on Wednesday cleared the way for two members of the Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena group to hold the 'Diwali Pahat' event on October 24 at Talao Pali area in Thane, by dismissing the plea filed by members of Shiv Sena (Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray) claiming that the Thane Municipal Corporation (TMC) had refused to grant it permission for the event with 'malafide' intention.

A division bench of Justice Ramesh D Dhanuka and Justice Kamal R Khata dismissed the plea on merits and refused to interfere in TMC's decision. The two Shiv Sena factions in Thane are at loggerheads over the venue for Diwali Pahat, an annual musical event held on the first morning of Diwali at Talao-pali area.

Diwali Pahat or Padwa Pahat is an integral part of the Diwali tradition in Maharashtra. Diwali for lakhs of the state's residents is associated with early morning soirees that see renowned artists performing on open air stage or auditoriums. Popularly known as Diwali Pahat, these performances are by well-known classical musicians including vocalists and instrumentalists.

The plea by three trustees of the Anand Charitable Trust, including former corporator

Mandar Pramod Vichare, had challenged the October 13 order of the civic body that permitted the Shinde faction of Shiv Sena to erect a pandal and stage for the Diwali Pahat event at a venue near Rajwant Jewellers, Talao Pali, in Thane. The preliminary permission was granted to the petitioners on October 10.

The petitioners, through sen-

ior advocate Vishwajeet Sawant, claimed that the impugned order was "illegal" and was an "abuse of process of law" and "against the principles of natural justice and equity, arbitrary". It said the receipt of the application by Shinde faction leaders Nitin Landge and Satyajeet Landge is shown to have been backdated or antedated and was granted by TMC "surrepti-

tiously". Respondents Nitin Landge and Satyajeet Landge, however, claimed that they had been conducting the musical event for the last 10 years.

The TMC, represented by senior advocate Ram Apte along with advocates Harshal Nahata and Mandar Limaye, opposed the plea and submitted that it had given permission

as per Section 234 of the Maharashtra Municipal Corporation Act, which empowers the commissioner to permit booths to be erected on streets during festivals. After perusing submissions and documents on record, the court said it could not find any malafide intention by the TMC while granting approval.

Stones pelted at house of Chiplun MLA embroiled in war of words with Rane, sons

UNKNOWN MISCREANTS pelted stones, threw a cricket stump and a petrol bottle in the compound of MLA Bhaskar Jadhav's bungalow in Chiplun in Ratnagiri district in the early hours of Wednesday.

An official from Chiplun police station confirmed the incident, adding no one was hurt and the bungalow was not damaged in the incident. Police said they suspect the idea was to threaten the MLA, who was not at home when the incident took place.

Jadhav's family, however, was at home and his son has given a complaint, based on which an FIR has been registered by the Chiplun police under IPC sections 436 (mischievous act) and 504 (intentional insult) of the Indian Penal Code.

to destroy house), 427 (mischievous act), 447 (criminal trespass), 511 (attempting to commit offences) and 34 (common intention).

Jadhav, who is part of the Shiv Sena-Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray, has been in the news for taking jibes at Union Minister Narayan Rane, who has a strong political hold in Konkarni region. Rane, the Union Minister of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and a BJP leader, was earlier with the Shiv Sena and served as the state chief minister when the Sena was in power.

The attack on Jadhav's bungalow comes in the backdrop of a war of words between Jadhav and Rane's two sons. While addressing a crowd, Jadhav had mimicked Narayan Rane and taken jibes at him, as well as accused him of corruption. Both

Rane's sons, Nitesh and Nilesh, had responded strongly, with the latter publicly cautioning the Sena leader to mind his words and in response, Jadhav had made some remarks against Nilesh.

In response to Jadhav's comments, Tukaram Sail, a BJP leader from Kudal in Sindhudurg, filed a complaint with local Kudal police, following which an FIR was registered by the police on Tuesday night.

Jadhav was booked under sections 153 (wantonly giving provocation with intent to cause riot—if rioting be committed), 505 (1)(c) (public mischief with intent to incite, or which is likely to incite, any class or community of persons to commit any offence against any other class or community), 500 (defamation) and 504 (intentional insult) of the Indian Penal Code.

After Pawar's letter, CM tells admin to ensure help for farmers hit by heavy rain

MAHARASHTRA CHIEF Minister Eknath Shinde on Wednesday directed district administrations to conduct panchamas on the damage caused by incessant rain in many parts of the state. Shinde's order came hours after Leader of Opposition and NCP leader Ajit Pawar held a meeting with him, demanding announcement of 'wet drought' in the state.

"The state government has announced a relief package for farmers affected by incessant rain. However, the returning monsoon too has wreaked havoc in many parts of the state. Concerned district collectors must immediately conduct panchamas and ensure help is provided to farmers," said Shinde.

On Wednesday, Pawar had submitted a letter to the CM, demanding announcement of wet drought in the state and provision of aid beyond the criteria of State Disaster Response Fund and National Disaster Response Fund. Meanwhile, NCP's state unit president Jayant Patil said, "The government must immediately announce a relief package for farmers."

Samata Party plea against 'flaming torch' symbol allotment quashed by HC

THE DELHI High Court on Wednesday dismissed Samata Party's plea challenging the October 10 decision of the Election Commission to allot 'flaming torch' as poll symbol to Shiv Sena (Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray) for the November 3 Andheri East Assembly bypoll.

A single-judge bench of Justice Sanjeev Narula held that Samata Party "failed to demonstrate" that they had a "vested right" in the symbol as the party was derecognised in 2004. Samata Party was founded in 1994 by former defence minister late George Fernandes and Nitish Kumar (current Bihar CM) as an offshoot of the Janata Dal. Uday Mandal is the current president of the party.

The counsel for Samata Party, Kamlesh Kumar Mishra, said that since the party had contested polls on the symbol in 2014, it was incumbent upon the EC to issue a notification before making 'flaming torch' a free symbol and allotting it to any other party.

He further argued that on October 12, the party president had made a representation to the Chief Election Commissioner and Election Commission, seeking to

withdraw the decision to allot the symbol "reserved" for Samata Party. "Since the petitioner lost the status of a recognised party in 2004, the right, if any, on the symbol in question would have lapsed after expiry of six years in terms of clause 10A of the Election Symbol Order. In such circumstances, the petitioner does not have a right over the symbol. If in 2014 the petitioner did contest a poll, that claim doesn't give a right in its favour in respect of the symbol in question," the court said.

The clause provides a concession to candidates set up by an unrecognised party which was earlier recognised as a national or state party. The EC argued that even in terms of this clause, the concession to Samata party does not exist in 2022.

Appearing for the EC, Sidhant Kumar submitted that there was no requirement for the EC to issue a notification, stating that the 'flaming torch' was a free symbol. Samata Party was granted recognition on October 24, 1994 and had contested the 2014 general elections on the 'flaming torch' symbol. However, it contested 2020 elections on a different symbol.

On October 10, the EC allotted 'flaming torch' as the poll symbol to the Thackeray camp.

PIL in HC seeks CBI, ED probe into 'disproportionate assets' of Thackerays

OMKAR GOKHALE MUMBAI, OCTOBER 19

A MUMBAI resident and her father recently moved a PIL in the Bombay High Court seeking direction to the CBI and ED to conduct a thorough and impartial investigation into the alleged disproportionate assets of former Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray and his family.

The plea came up for hearing before a division bench of Justice S V Gangapurwala and Justice R N Laddha on Wednesday. The bench noticed certain objections were raised by the HC Registry in the PIL and gave two weeks to the petitioner to remove and correct them and posted the matter for further hearing on November 16.

The petitioner, Gouri Abhay Bhide (38), who along with her 78-year-old father filed the PIL, claimed Uddhav Thackeray, his wife Rashmi, son and former state minister Aaditya, and their other son Tejas, have never disclosed any service, profession, or business as their particular source of income and have amassed disproportionate assets.

Bhide, a resident of Dadar, said her family was in the printing business like the Thackerays and briefly printed supplements of late Bal Thackeray's weekly during the Emergency period. They said the 'Saamana' mouthpiece and 'Marmik' magazine were never subject to audit by

the audit bureau of circulation and no one knows their print order. She added that during the coronavirus pandemic entire print media was facing losses, but Thackeray's publication showed a record turnover of Rs 42 crore and record profit of Rs 11.5 crore and it is a case of "turning black money into white money".

She added that the Prabodhan Prakashan Pvt Ltd had no turnover to report till 2018 and "miraculously it increased in 2019 to Rs 37.18 crore with profit of Rs 3.25 crore and in 2020, turnover was Rs 44 crore and the firm booked profit of nearly Rs 9 crore".

She said she had submitted a complaint and a reminder on July 11 and July 26 relating to the above facts to the Mumbai police, but no action was taken and it was only forwarded by the Police Commissioner to its Economic Offences Wing (EOW).

The PIL sought direction to the central agencies to take cognisance of the complaint filed with the Mumbai police and investigate it. It also said the status of the probe should be submitted to the court every month.

While commenting on the petition, Shiv Sena MLA and former minister Aaditya Thackeray said, "If anyone wanted to witness our wealth then they should have come to Dussehra rally at Shivaji Park. Shiv Sainiks are our wealth."
